1. Nominations open on Wednesday, 11 January 2017 and must reach the relevant Returning Officer, Australian Electoral Commission at the office or postal address of the AEC as outlined in the how to lodge nominations section listed on this form, not later than 12.00 noon (**Local time at the office or postal address of the AEC** on Wednesday, 25 January 2017). Candidate may withdraw his/her nomination not later than 12.00 noon. (**Local time at the office or postal address of the AEC** on Wednesday, 1 February 2017). Withdrawal of nominations also require the consent of all nominators.

2. Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

3. As a candidate you will be sent an acknowledgment.

4. It is your responsibility to ensure that your nomination is received by the Returning Officer, **BEFORE** nominations close.

5. Where a candidate has nominated for more offices than the rules allow, the Returning Officers will only consider the nomination received last in time. Where the Returning Officer is unable to determine which nomination was received last in time, all nominations will be defected.

6. As per Rule 61(9) - Nominations must be forwarded in a closed envelope addressed to the Returning Officer. Intending candidates who are lodging their nomination in the Australia Post mail system should ensure their nomination reaches the Returning Officer during the nomination time period. Advice on mail delivery options and delivery times can be obtained from Australia Post.

HOW TO LODGE NOMINATIONS

It is the responsibility of the person submitting their nomination form to ensure it is received by the **relevant** Returning Officer before the close of nomination.
