The Emergency Transport Scheme is one of the ways in which the AWU Victorian Branch works to maintain and improve the well-being of its members and their families.

The scheme is open to members who have had 12 months of continuous financial membership of the AWU.

All claims must be made within three months of the event. Before making a claim, make sure you have read the conditions carefully. The ideal would be that no AWU member or their family needed to make a claim, but sometimes things do go wrong. It is another way in which the Union provides backing when it is most needed.

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Are you an AWU Member who has:

- ✓ Been a continual and current financial member of the AWU – Victorian Branch for more than 12 months
- ✓ Permanent residency in the State of Victoria

If you answered ‘yes’ to both of the above questions then you and your family members (including dependants) are covered by the AWU’s Emergency Transport Scheme (ETS).

This Scheme covers:

- Ambulance treatment provided by Ambulance Services Victoria for medical or surgical cases
- Ambulance transport from medically authorised emergency cases provided by Ambulance Services Victoria
- Interstate Benefits and Coverage as in Victoria
- Family Dependants
 - including spouses, partners (legal or defacto)
 - dependent children under the age of 17 or
 - dependant children engaged in full time study at a secondary or tertiary education institute provided they are single and under the age of 25

This scheme does not cover:

- The Royal Flying Doctor Service
- AWU membership in other States within Australia and is not transferable
- When payment is the responsibility of any third party
- When transport is required between private homes for relocation
- Residence located outside the areas serviced either by MAS or RAV

Please note that the AWU ETS is a private Scheme and is NOT associated with Ambulance Victoria or membership with Ambulance Victoria. However we apply the same conditions as if you were a full member with Ambulance Victoria.
